Mission Statement

St. John's Parish family prayerfully worships, studies, teaches and lives our faith in Jesus Christ.

Old School Building Update

We met with The Glenn Company last week to discuss what has been done on the old school project and what our next steps will be. The Glenn Company has done the following:

- Ordered and reviewed a senior housing demand study for the site. This was completed by Viewpoint Consulting. The study shows there is current demand for an independent living site.
- Analyzed current market rates and competitive comparable properties.
- Met with the City of Jordan to discuss City involvement including Tax Increment Financing and the City's interest in buying/occupying the 1st floor space.
- Sized the site for an independent senior housing project.
- Determined rental unit, office square footage and parking capacity of the site and developed a unit mix model.
- Based on the market rent analysis developed a Market Rate Assumption schedule.
- Completed a Development Budget Estimate.
- Completed a Project Income and Expense Proforma.
- Completed a Project Summary with debt and equity requirements and income/cost gap.
- Completed a Required Rents Proforma and Project Summary.

The next steps include a meeting with the City of Jordan and a follow up meeting with our committee. Currently, the projected numbers fall short of the project sustaining itself. The Glenn Company will look into other options for financing and investing.

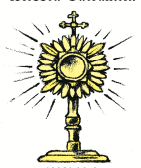

Parish Council, April 25th Meeting

The Parish Council did a line by line review and was briefed on the 2017-2018 preliminary Parish/School budget. The main concern is that our current rate of giving is not keeping up with expenses and needs, with anticipated shortfalls becoming a reality.

A status and feasibility report on the old school property proposal should be completed in May.

Many nominations were received for the two open seats on the Council. Members will begin making calls to identify possible candidates; short bios will be printed in the May 10th bulletin, with election scheduled the weekend of May 20/21.

Faith Formation

It's the Small Things

Last Saturday marked the 100 year anniversary of Mary's first appearance to the 3 children of Fatima. Our Mother appeared to the children on the 13th of every month for 6 months urging the children to pray for sinners. In July, Mary told the children, "Sacrifice yourselves for sinners, and say often this prayer, especially during any sacrifice: *"O my Jesus, I offer this for love of Thee, for the conversion of poor sinners, and in reparation for all the sins committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary."* (www.theholyroary.org) Last summer I listened to the Lighthouse Media CD, *Power in Prayer* with Sister Mary Gabriel, SV. In her talk she mentioned a story about a Bishop who was going through a dark period in his faith. One night while he was sleeping he woke-up and saw a vision of a nun he never met before; at that moment he also felt whatever was attacking his faith leave him. The next day he was saying Mass at a nearby convent and as he was distributing communion he recognized one of the sisters receiving communion as the same woman he saw in his vision. After Mass he asked the Mother Superior to introduce him to this nun. In meeting her he asked, "Sister, do you pray often for your Bishops?" The nun answered meekly, "Oh no, your Holiness, not nearly enough. Only when I fold my laundry."

It's so easy to forget the power of prayer and that our daily tasks can be used for the greater good! God can use these 'sacrifices' not only for sinners but for your son, daughter, grandchild, neighbor, whomever; we just have to offer them up to Him!
